>>> FEDERAL COURT UPDATE

Effective May 11, 2025, the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts (AO) began implementing multifactor authentication (MFA) to enhance system security for CM/ECF and PACER. MFA provides an added layer of security to accounts by helping protect against cyberattacks that steal passwords. Once implemented, all CM/ECF and PACER users will be able to enroll in MFA. While the REAL ID Act ("Act") went into effect on May 7, 2025 and restricted access to certain federal facilities, the Act contains an exception for access to court proceedings and services. An acceptable of identification form required to be shown courthouse entry, however a REAL ID card is not required to enter the federal courthouses in the Western District. 
